Where there are joint registered holders of any shares in the Company, any one of such persons may vote at the Meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such shares as if he were solely entitled thereto; but if more than one of such joint holders are present at the Meeting personally or by proxy, that one of the said persons so present whose name stands first on the 7. register of members of the Company in respect of such shares shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.

- To be valid, this form of proxy, together with the power of attorney (if any) or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or other 8. authority, must be deposited at the Investor Centre of the Company's share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the Meeting (i.e. at or before 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, 29 August 2012) or any adjournment thereof.
